



## Professor Thomas Abel

**T**homas Abel is Professor for Health Research at the Institute of Social and Preventive Medicine at the University of Bern, Switzerland (<http://www.ispm.ch>). A Medical Sociologist with a focus on structure-agency perspectives, his major research program addresses issues of social stratification and inequalities in health and health behaviours.

**P**rior to his appointment in Bern he was Professor for Public Health and Epidemiology, Dep. of Medicine at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University, Munich, FRG (1993 - 95), Lecturer and Research Assistant in Medical Sociology, Dep. of Medicine at the Philipps-University, Marburg, Germany (1986 - 93) and Teaching and Research Assistant, Dep. of Sociology at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, USA (1984 - 86).

His academic degrees include a Habilitation at Philipps-University in Marburg (Dep. of Medicine, 1993), a Ph.D. from the University of Illinois (Dep. of Sociology) in 1989, a Master's (1980) and a Dr.phil. (1984) degree from the Justus Liebig-University in Giessen (Dep. of Sports Science). He has been a visiting Professor at Univ. de Montreal in 2005 (Dép. de médecine sociale et préventive) and at UBC Vancouver in 2012 (Dep. of Sociology).

**T**homas Abel has published widely on theoretical and empirical challenges in social science applied in Public Health. As Editor-in-Chief he has led the *International Journal of Public Health* from 2000 until 2011. He has also served as reviewer and advisor for major national and international research institutions and funding agencies.
